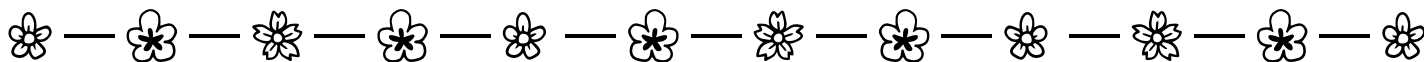




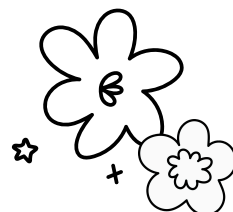

## Summer To-Do List

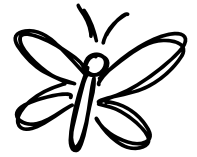


### Things to Brainstorm & Plans to Design:

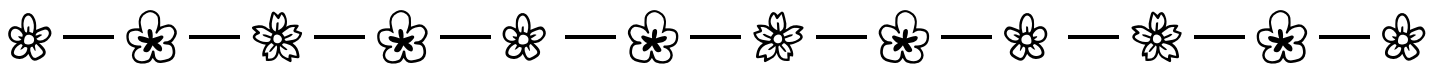
- Words to describe your classroom vibe
- A sketch of your classroom layout
- Plan out all routines & procedures (grab a checklist!)
- List of routines to teach in Week 1
- Community-building activities for Week 1
- Running list of questions to ask your team/mentor
- Student areas & systems (turning in work, shared supplies, storing backpacks, etc.)
- Your instructional space (document camera, anchor charts, teacher notebook, lesson copies, etc.)
- Teaching class rules
- System for early finishers and warm-ups
- Managing grades
- Returning graded work & sending papers home
- Storing & organizing your teaching materials
- Student folders and notebooks (take-home folder, unfinished work, HW, color-coded notebooks, etc.)
- Classroom jobs
- Calm-down area or SEL corner
- Managing student absences
- Displaying learning targets
- Daily attendance
- Tracking how students get home each day
- Daily lunch count or managing lunch boxes
- Labeling student desks, cubbies, book bins, lockers, etc.
- Door decor & bulletin boards
- Displaying student work
- Student birthdays



# Things to Create & Research to Do:



- New team's emails or phone numbers
- List of routines and procedures
- Your school's grading system and procedures
- Your grade level's assessment and data collection methods
- Simple, independent printables for emergency sub plans
- Key learning standards for your subject/grade
- Map out key dates (start/end units, report cards, PD days)
- Identify important staff members (custodian, SpEd, tech support, counselor, front office, etc.)
- Meet the Teacher page
- Page to collect parent info
- Daily agenda or lesson slides
- Home/parent communication system
- Weekly planning template for calendar events and lessons
- Cheat-sheet template for your students' IEP/504/EL accommodations
- Student survey of interests, needs, home life, background, etc.
- Template for daily class schedule
- Weekly homework template
- Class roster template
- Classroom newsletter
- Parent contact log
